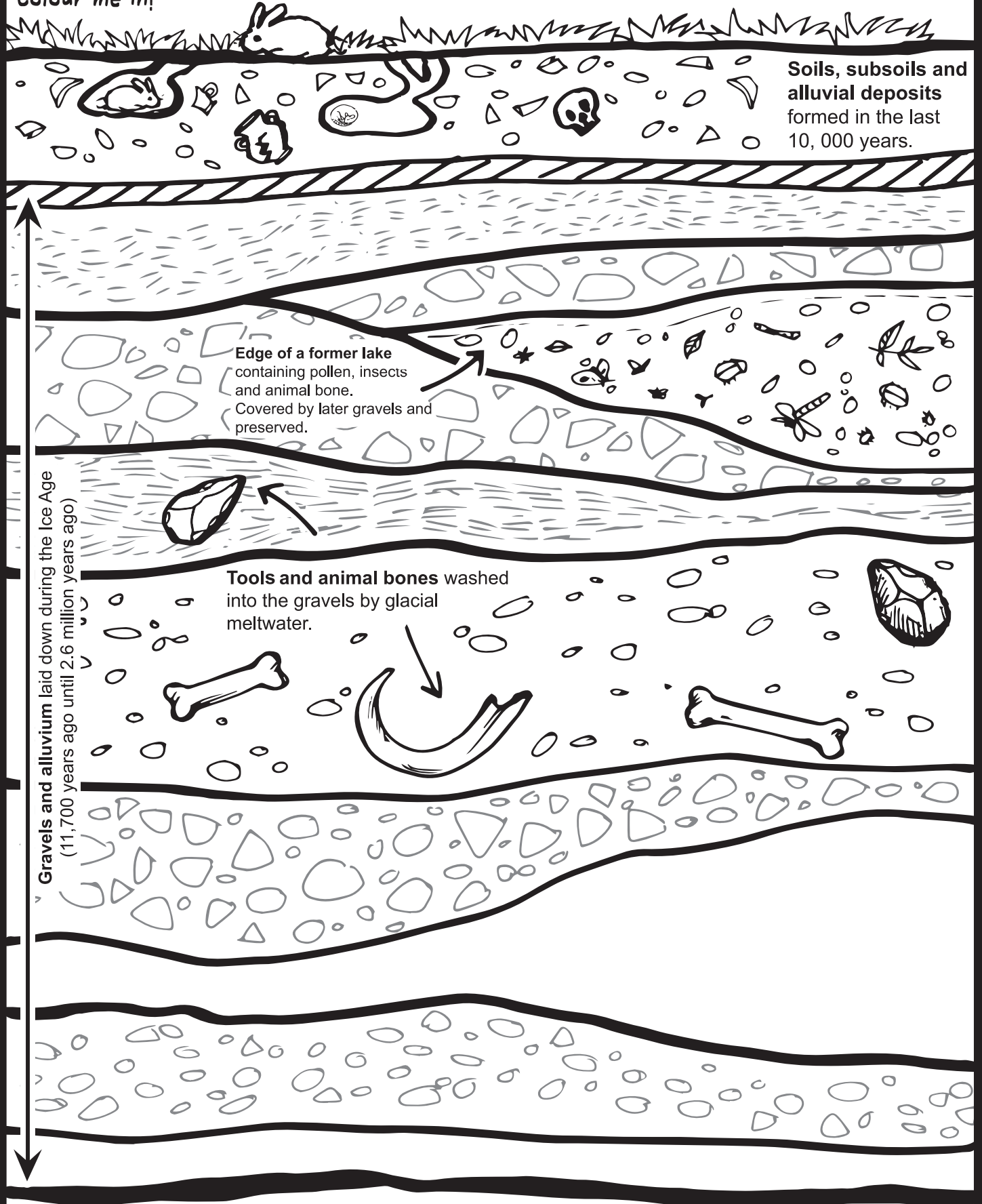


GEOLOGICAL LAYERS.

Underlying solid geology

- largely mudstone and sandstone in Worcestershire formed over 200 million years ago.

Alluvium = a deposit of clay, silt, and / or sand left by flowing water.
Gravels = larger stones and rocks left by faster flowing water usually at the end of a cold period as the ice melts.
